GRIEVE DEEPLY AND CONSCIENTIOUSLY

from Hurting to Healing Bible Reading Challenge

You've experienced brokenness on some level. Maybe you've lost a loved one, experienced disease, or encountered heart-breaking circumstances. Maybe the suffering has been long and the wound in your heart feels like a gaping hole, racked with pain. The word "healing" is an interesting word. As a noun, it means "the process of making or becoming sound or healthy again." As a verb, it means, "tending to heal; therapeutic." What's striking is that neither definition is instantaneous. Each one indicates that healing is a gradual, moment-by-moment process. Discover the path to embracing God's healing hand on your heart.
