Why Are We So Afraid?

Uncertainty About Divine Concern and Protection.

Habakkuk 1 (2) O Lord, how long must I call for help before you listen, before you save us from violence? (3) Why do you make me see such trouble? How can you stand to look on such wrongdoing? Destruction and violence are all around me, and there is fighting and quarreling everywhere. (GNT)

Psalms 142 (4) When I look beside me, I see that there is no one to help me, no one to protect me. No one cares for me. (GNT)

Certainty About Divine Concern and Protection

Hebrews 13 (5) For God has said, "I will never fail you. I will never abandon you." (6) So, we can say with confidence, "The Lord is my helper, so I will have no fear. What can mere people do to me?" (NLT)
